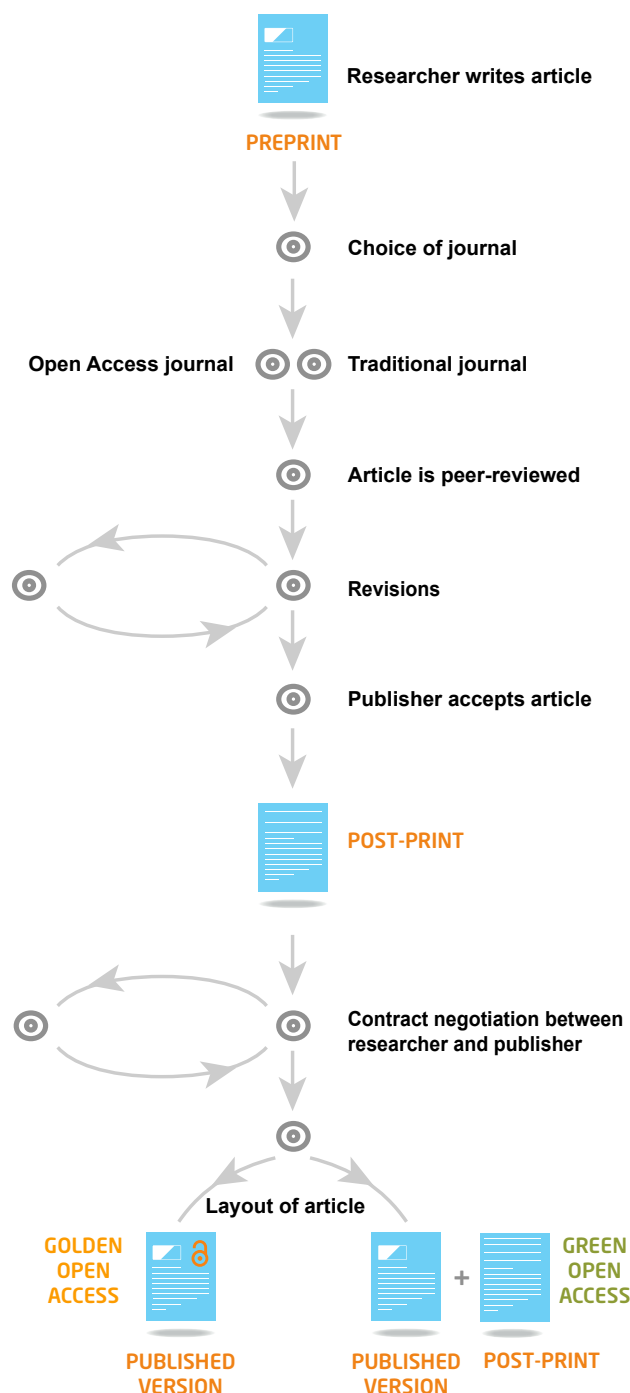


TWO WAYS TO OPEN ACCESS



OPEN ACCESS ARCHIVING

SAVE YOUR REVISIONS

Save your pre-print and post-print. This will give you more possibilities for making your articles Open Access.

FUNDING

If you apply for funding for your research then make an entry in the budget for publishing. Open Access publishing might require a fee. It is also worth paying attention to the fact that many funders today demand that research is made Open Access.

COPYRIGHT

Get to know your rights and read your contract and copyright transfer agreement thoroughly. DTU has a standard contract for publishing that can secure your rights.

RESEARCH REGISTRATION BY DTU LIBRARY

A team from DTU Library registers all your research and might contact you to get your post-print to upload in DTU Orbit.

GREEN OPEN ACCESS

Green Open Access is when you publish in a traditional journal and your scientific article following is made available online for free e.g. by being uploaded in DTU Orbit or another repository.

GOLDEN OPEN ACCESS

Golden Open Access is when you publish your article in a purely Open Access journal.
