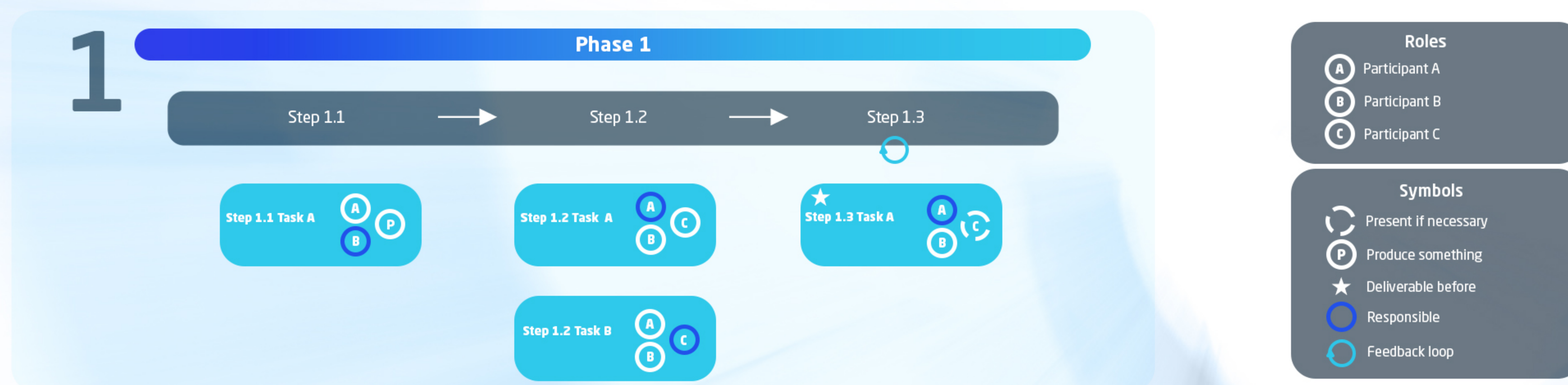


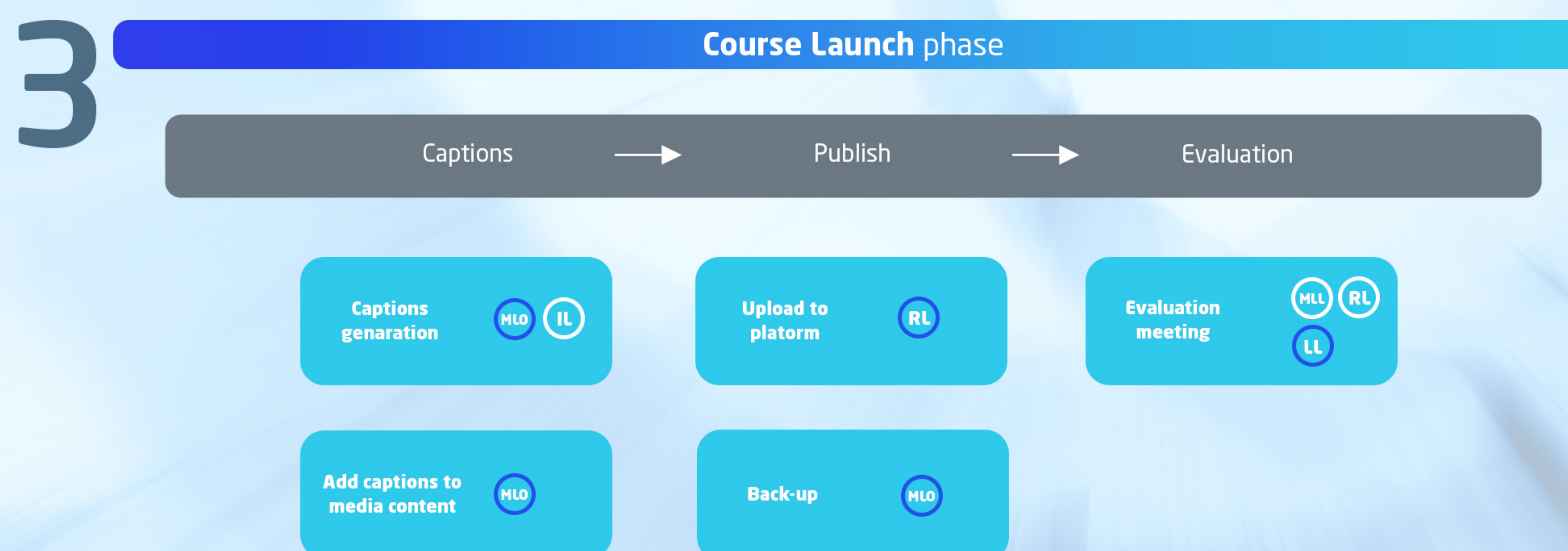
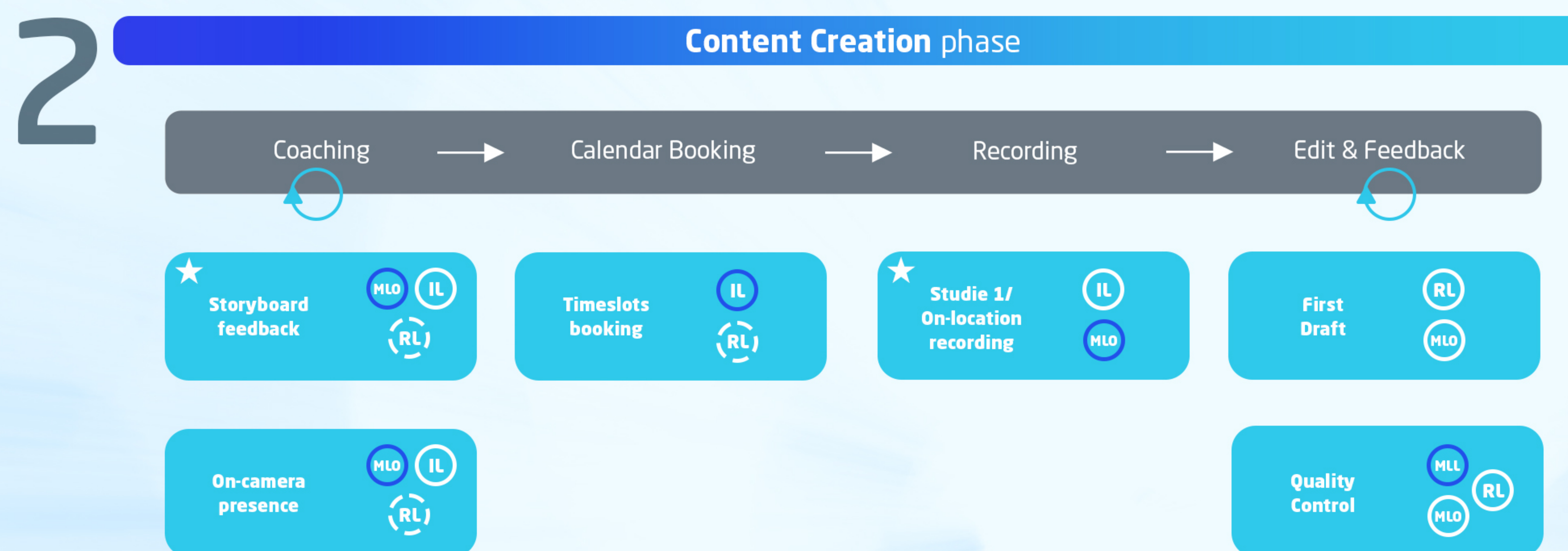
How to read this roadmap

The roadmap for creating an online course is based on phases, steps and tasks assigned to certain roles or people. Each role has an icon: the abbreviation of the role in a circle. The colored circle (blue) indicates that this role holds the key responsibility for the task's completion. The white circles indicate that these roles are involved in completing the task, but do not bear the responsibility.



Symbols can be added to specific tasks indicating specific attributes assigned to a role e.g. if the role is responsible, **(Responsible)** or if the role's participation is voluntary **(Present if necessary)**. The symbols can also say something about the tasks characteristics e.g. is the task's goal to produce something **(Produce something)** or is a deliverable needed before initiating the task **(Deliverable before)**.

Finally, a step can be repetitive. This symbol is added to a step when tasks in the step are repeated **(Feedback loop)**
